Course Description / Prerequisites Intermediate Drawing (3 credits, Half Year)
This course is an exploration of painting techniques, styles, and materials (tempera, acrylic, watercolor, and ink). Emphasis will be on composition and aesthetic development, continuing to keep and use a sketchbook, developing ideas and themes, and the understanding of basic color theory. The Foundations and Intermediate Drawing courses are pre-requisites, as this course will build on those skills.
